Special Voters' Meeting

There will be a special Voters' Meeting on Monday, May 7 at 6:00 p.m. There will a few changes concerning our school and if you are a member at Martin Luther, we encourage you to attend. It was presented to our leadership and then passed at Trinity's Voters' Meeting to implement the following, pending Martin Luther's approval. Our 7-8 graders would be sent to Trinity at our current tuition rate and Martin Luther would subsidize the costs of Trinity's tuition rate. This would relieve us from having to call 2 full time positions. On Thursday, April 26 the church council and the school board met to discuss our options moving forward and agreed that this is a significant step forward in our 3 yr. plan to merge the two schools together.

To fill our need for a first and second grade teacher and school music director, we will Call a graduate from Martin Luther College. Tyler Weinich would then teach grades 5-6 and continue as technology director.

At this meeting we are seeking approval to move our 7-8 grade classes to Trinity for 2018-19 and apply for a MLC graduate to serve as a teacher for our grades 1-2 and be the school music coordinator.
